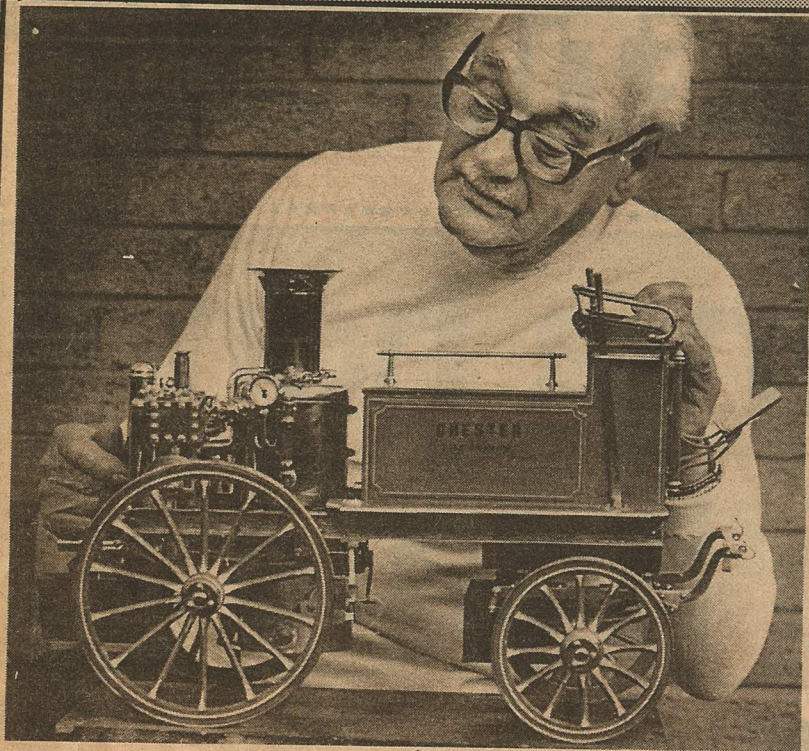

Arthur's chuffed with his hobby

For 49 years, Arthur Shaw worked for the company now known as the British Steel Corporation, in engineering maintenance and later, as a safety officer.

Fascinated with engineering, Arthur began building scaled down models of steam, gas and petroleum engines — a hobby he has pursued for the past 60 years.

Since retiring 16 years ago, and moving from Manchester to a bungalow in the shadow of the Little Orme, 82-year-old Arthur has built ten working models.

"I don't have a set routine," he

said, "I just go into my workshop when I am in the mood. There are no plans available for many of the engines I build, so I draw them up myself using photographs as a guide."

Arthur, who is a member of the North Wales Model Engineering Society, is pictured with a two inch scale model of an old London Steam Fire Engine of the type in use at the turn of the century.

It took over a year to build, every single component having been fashioned out of brass or stainless steel in Arthur's workshop.

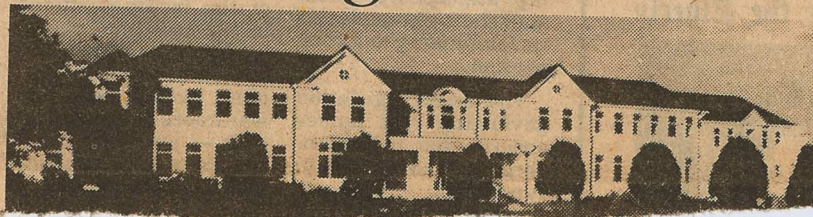
